**ORDER DENYING DEFENDANT
GOVERNOR HOWARD DEAN'S MOTION
FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

Upon consideration of Defendant Dean's Motion for Summary Judgment ("Motion"), Plaintiff's Consolidated Opposition to Defendants' Motions for Summary Judgment thereto ("Opposition"), and the record herein, the Court denies the Motion because of the genuine issues of material fact in dispute, which include but are not limited to the following: (1) whether Defendant Dean's statement made in the IN Magazine interview was defamatory¹; and (2) whether he aided and abetted the Democratic National Committee ("DNC") by participating in a scheme to discriminate and retaliate that resulted in Plaintiff's termination of his position at the DNC.

¹ "A communication is defamatory if it tends so to harm the reputation of another as to lower him in the estimation of the community to deter third persons from associating or dealing with him." Restatement Second, Torts § 559.
